1. **Project Title: Membership Recruitment**

Results: We recruited 450 new members, reinstated 126 members, and renewed 1,749 members during the past year. Total current membership now stands at 2,592 members. The committee, based upon the information supplied in the monthly membership reports, continues to contact new members to welcome them aboard and purged members to remind them to renew their membership. Committee members continue to distribute NACM informational material at local organizational meetings and individualized invitations to join NACM have

been sent by many members. Officers and other Board members have attended several state and/or regional educational conferences to speak on the benefits of membership. Subcommittee efforts have continued with the special project to recruit tribal court members, resulting in the addition of several tribal court Judges and administrators.
