MEMBER DONATION PROGRAM

The National Association for Court Management (NACM) is a non-profit professional association with membership of more than 2,000 court managers worldwide. NACM's purpose is to increase the proficiency of those who manage courts through the exchange of information.

The NACM President in consultation with the Chair of the Conference Development Committee and the Chair(s) of the Membership Committee may donate up to a maximum of five annual NACM memberships per calendar year to Federal, State or Regional Association who share similar purposes with our organization and enhance the completion of our continuing educational programs.

PURPOSE

- To encourage greater participation in local and national organizations whose purpose is to improve the administration of justice
- To increase and recognize greater levels of cooperation between such organizations and NACM
- To promote knowledge and interest in NACM with the expectation that the individual recipient of the donated membership will share as much of the distributed membership materials and information with as many colleagues as possible.
- To help identify future court leaders
- To act as recruiting tool for both NACM and local associations

CRITERIA

The criteria will be based on the following:

1. The location of future mid-year and annual conferences and the degree of involvement from local organization
2. The utilization of NACM's programs such as the Core Competencies and the invitation to NACM's president to provide speakers to speak to the benefits of NACM
3. The attendance of their organizations representative at the Leadership Seminar conducted at the Annual Conference
4. The number of members who attend the mid-year or Annual Conference
5. The number of NACM members from any particular State
6. The award(s) cannot be made to the same organization two consecutive years
7. The intent of this program is not to supplant any current NACM member
