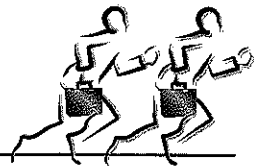

Dear Warner:

I am enclosing the original Certificate of Registration of the servicemark "NACM", which was issued August 21, 2007. This is an important legal document which may have to be produced at a later time to evidence the registration rights it represents. For that reason, you should keep it in a safe and secure location with other important legal documents. We will maintain a copy in our files.

In order to obtain maximum benefits from this registration and protect the rights in this servicemark, we recommend the following:

1. Use of the federal registration symbol "®" in each instance where the servicemark is used in advertising, correspondence, or otherwise; and
2. Diligent enforcement of trademark rights against any infringing uses of the servicemark. While this registration confirms rights in the mark, these rights can change over time through use (or misuse) of the mark, and through the use by others of conflicting marks. For these reasons, we urge you to consult with us from time to time, and to establish procedures to identify and challenge the use by others of conflicting marks. At the very least, a cease and desist letter would be the first step in such diligence, once an infringing use is called to your attention.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW

Because actions must be taken periodically to maintain this servicemark registration in force, it is imperative that you keep us advised of any address changes as well as any changes in the ownership of intellectual property rights. Please be sure to notify us of any address changes so that we can reach you to advise you of action that will have to be undertaken to maintain these rights in force.

Also, an affidavit must be filed between the fifth and sixth years of registration, that is, between **August 21, 2012** and **August 21, 2013**, demonstrating continued use of this mark in interstate commerce. Otherwise, the registration will be cancelled. In addition, a similar affidavit filed at the same time will allow this registration to become incontestable under the law. This gives the registrant increased rights against possible infringing uses. While we have added this information to our docket, and will attempt to remind you that such confirmation should be provided to the Patent and Trademark Office at the appropriate time, for a variety of reasons it may not be possible for us to do this. Accordingly, you should add this date to your calendar.

If the registration is maintained in force by filing confirmation of the continued use of the mark during the fifth year of registration, as previously noted, it will nevertheless expire ten years from the date the registration was issued, that is on **August 21, 2017**. The registration may be renewed by an application proving use filed for that purpose within one year prior to expiration of the registration, or within six months following such expiration. Again, while we have added these dates to our docket, and will endeavor to notify you of the expiration of the registration at that time, for various reasons this may not be possible. We suggest that you therefore take such steps as you deem appropriate to independently remind yourself that the registration should be renewed.
